The London Mathematical Society was founded in 1865 for the promotion and extension of mathematical knowledge and is now the major British learned society for mathematics. Its principal activities are the publication of journals and books and the organization of meetings and conferences. Members of the Society are entitled to subscribe to the Society's journals, and certain other mathematical journals, for their personal use at reduced rates. Also, copies of books in series sponsored by the Society are available to members for their personal use at discounted prices. A monthly newsletter is distributed free of charge to members. The Society has reciprocity membership agreements with many other national mathematical societies. Information concerning the activities of the Society and nomination forms for membership can be obtained from the Administrator at the above address.

Pricing Policy. Recognising the importance of the dissemination of mathematical knowledge, the threats of rising prices of journals and falling library budgets, and the Society's objectives of increasing its support for mathematical activities, the Council of the Society will continue to seek to expand its activities in publishing but intends that the prices of its journals should not rise in real terms (against inflation) except in as far as there is added content or value.

Submission of papers to the *Proceedings*, *Journal* and *Bulletin*. Papers are submitted jointly to the three journals; the Editors make the final decision on which journal may accept the paper. Longer papers are normally published in the *Proceedings*, and those of medium length in the *Journal*. The *Bulletin* publishes short research papers, survey articles, book reviews and obituaries. The Editors are J. W. ANDERSON and J. BRODZKI (*Bulletin*); F. E. BURSTALL and J. F. TOLAND (*Journal*); C. TELEMANN and B. TOTARO (*Proceedings*).

Authors wishing to submit a paper for publication in the *Proceedings*, *Journal* or *Bulletin* should follow the guidelines on the web page

Authors will be asked to assign copyright to the Society prior to publication. No paper submitted should have previously been published or be under consideration for publication elsewhere. Nor may the paper be submitted elsewhere while it remains under consideration by the London Mathematical Society. Papers will not be returned to authors. The Society cannot accept responsibility for loss of manuscripts.

Preparation of manuscripts. Guidance may be sought from the Society's web page

An abstract written in English should be included at the beginning of the paper. Classification numbers from the 2000 Mathematics Subject Classification scheme of *Mathematical Reviews* and the *Zentralblatt für Mathematik* should appear at the bottom of the first page. References should be collected in alphabetical order at the end of the paper and numbered consecutively. All references should be cited in the main text.

Authors are encouraged to prepare their manuscripts using lms.cls, which can be downloaded together with a concise user guide from the web page cited above.
